

Kinsmen Poker Tournament Rules – May 17, 2014

Start Up Chip Amount = 25,000

Max of 3 Rebuys \$80 ea. Re-buy = 25,000 chips

Maximum entries of 58 players for tournament.

The top eight individuals in the tournament will receive cash prizes. Prize pool is based on 70 % of total revenue from entry fees plus 50% of rebuys and add-ons.

The top eight individuals in the tournament will receive cash prizes.

% of Total Prize Pool: 1st - 40%, 2nd - 20%, 3rd - 10%, 4th - 9%, 5th - 8%, 6th - 6%, 7th - 4%, 8th - 3%

Minimum raise or re-raise must be at least the amount of the big blind or all in.

There will be up to three rebuys allowed, only in the first two hours, and then each remaining competitor can add on. If an individual has had three rebuys, they are not allowed to add on.

There is a 16 person minimum requirement of players for the tournament to take place. If at 15 minutes before start time, there are not 16 people present, the event will be cancelled and everyone will receive a refund in cash or returned cheque. All entry fees will be on hand.

Individuals, if there is an emergency and they are unable to make the tournament will be able to withdraw with a full refund up to 5 pm on the Thursday before the tournament.

Individuals, if they are unable to make the tournament can transfer their entry ticket to another person.

The lowest denomination of chip will be eliminated at the break at 5 pm. If a player has 50% or more of the new chip value they will get a chip, less and they will not. Chips will be eliminated at each of the next two breaks with the same rules applying.

Play will continue until all but one player is eliminated. The order to finish shall be the order of elimination from last to first. The last remaining player shall be declared the winner.

If multiple players are eliminated on the same hand, the players starting the hand with the larger amount of chips finishes in the higher place for the prize money and any other awards, in the event that players started the hand with the same amount of chips, they will be declared tied and will share equally in the prize money or award.

If a player leaves the table, his hand will post and fold unless he/she returns by the time it is his/her turn to act. His/her blind will be posted and the hand will fold when there is action. If at any time a player is absent for more than 10 minutes, they will be eliminated from the tournament and their chips removed from play.

Only English may be spoken during the tournament.

There are no late entries unless the host has arranged chips in an empty seat for a "prepaid" player and instructs the dealer to post and fold, then a late player may be allowed to take that seat for up to 2 blind levels. The cards must be dealt to that player even if the seat is empty. If the seat is not claimed, then the remaining chips are simply removed from the tournament.

If a player's behavior disturbs the tournament organizers or other players the player will be ejected without refund.

No side betting allowed. Players involved in any form of side betting will be removed from the tournament without compensation.

Rebuy Rules. Players may purchase rebuys—to a maximum of 3 rebuys—until 5:00 p.m.

Rule for the elimination of players. Players are eliminated when they are out of chips.

Play will begin at 3:00 pm. Blind's will be raised every 20 minutes except during the supper break.
