Southwest Manitoba Tour



Guest choosing this option will tour one of the world's most iconic monuments to peace. The International Peace Gardens boasts acres of beautiful gardens and monuments. At the center is a peace tower, a 120 foot reminder of the world's longest undefended border. Guests can also tour the Peace Chapel, 9/11 Memorial, Interpretive Center, beautiful fountains and a working floral clock. Lunch will be served in the dining room with a view of the Peace Tower.



After lunch, the tour continues to Souris, MB where you can visit one of the best agate gemstone collection sites. These gems can be polished at the Rock Shop where many other stones and fossils can be seen. Souris is also home to Canada's longest historic suspension bridge. "The Swinging Bridge" stretches over 500 feet! Guest can also tour "The Plum" museum, the Victoria Bird Sanctuary.

Historical Explorers Museum Tour
